Suggested Driving Directions on Peachtree Rd and Peachtree Industrial Blvd (see the Course Map and Street List at www.131atlanta.com)

Traffic from Peachtree Rd & Brookhaven Dr to Peachtree Industrial & Johnson Ferry during the race (during approximately 7:13am-10:35am)

- From Peachtree Rd & Brookhaven Dr to Peachtree Industrial & Johnson Ferry, the west side of Peachtree will be coned for runners, and the east side of Peachtree will be coned for 1 northbound traffic lane and 1 southbound traffic lane.
- In the coned runners' lanes, **runners have the right of way**, except for emergency vehicles. Police will control traffic at each traffic intersection and will not allow drivers to cross the runners' lanes except when there is a gap in the runners.
- When the last runners/walkers have passed each mile, the road will be returned to normal traffic usage (see the Street List for times at each mile point). The last participants turn from Peachtree Rd onto Lanier by approximately 10:35am, after which all lanes of Peachtree Rd and Peachtree Industrial return to normal traffic usage.

On Peachtree Rd and Peachtree Industrial Blvd northbound –

Right turns are allowed. Example – a right turn onto Dresden Dr or Redding Rd is allowed.

Left turns are not allowed between Brookhaven Dr and Johnson Ferry except during gaps in the runners.

To avoid delays, drivers with left turns from Peachtree are advised to travel before 7:13am or after 10:35am, if possible.

On Peachtree Rd and Peachtree Industrial Blvd southbound –

Left turns are allowed. Example – a left turn onto Redding Rd or Dresden Dr is allowed.

Right turns are not allowed between Johnson Ferry and Brookhaven Dr except during gaps in the runners.

To avoid delays, drivers with right turns from Peachtree are advised to travel before 7:13am or after 10:35am, if possible.

To Reach Ashford Dunwoody or Johnson Ferry from Peachtree Rd -

Before 7:15am and after 8:00am - From Peachtree Rd, turn North on Peachtree Dunwoody, turn right (East) on Windsor Parkway, turn Left (North) on Ashford Dunwoody, turn left on Johnson Ferry.

During 7:15am–8:00am – There is no eastbound traffic lane on Windsor Parkway between Mabry and Lanier during 7:15am-8:00am.

Please plan your drive in advance, start early, and allow extra time. If you are taking an unfamiliar route, consider taking a practice drive before race day.
